Salisbury I buildings are 40 years old and as such more preventive
measures must be taken for the safety of its residents.

Therefore: each unit must be equipped with at least one smoke alarm
equipped with a 10 year battery life to be installed in the hall between the
living and sleeping areas.

Failure to comply with this bylaw may result in the failure of insurance to
cover fire and/or smoke damage by both home owners and building
insurance in the event of fire damage to your unit or other units damaged in
said fire.

The deadline for compliance is March 1, 2016.
